Guidance Documents

- Health and Safety Planning Guide for Planners, Safety Officers and Supervisors for Protecting Responders Following a Nuclear Detonation
 - Interagency document being developed by HHS, DHS, DOL, EPA, DOE
 - QRG for responders
 - Cleared by the DRG in September, at OMB



Guidance Documents

- EPA Protective Action Guides (PAG) Manual
 - EPA has incorporated input from public and agency comments
 - Currently awaiting final OMB approval
 - A chapter on drinking water guidance will likely be added once it is approved by OMB
 - Publication in full form November 2016 goal
